Manitoba Beef Cattle Performance Ass'n Douglas Bull Test Station, Carberry, Man. 112-day final report (Feb. 28, 2017)

The 53rd Manitoba Beef Cattle Performance Association Bull & Heifer Development Test accepted delivery Oct. 11-14, 2016, at the Douglas Bull Test Station in Carberry, Man., Canada. Consignors must be members of the Manitoba Beef Cattle Association, and bulls must have been born Jan. 1-April 30, 2016, to be eligible for the 112-day test.

A total of 140 bulls were weighed on test Nov. 7-8, with Blonde D'Aquitaine, Limousin, Salers, Angus*, Simmental, Maine Anjou and Shorthorn breeds represented. The average on-test WDA for the Angus bulls was 3.04 lb. Overall on-test WDA was 3.02 lb.

112-day final report (March 1, 2017)

The 24th annual Washington Cattlemen's Association (WCA) All-Breed Bull Test began Nov. 3, 2016, with the initial weigh-in of 126 bulls consisting of 69 Angus, 31 Hereford, 13 Red Angus, four Angus composites, and nine Simmental. The bulls were fed under the supervision of Bob and Nina Lundgren at their Bonina Feed Facility at Eltopia.

Bulls eligible for the 120-day test were born Jan. 1-March 31, 2016. Genetic profile enhancement through DNA samples will be used on many of the bulls selling.

Edisto Forage Bull Test **Edisto Research & Education Center,** Blackville, S.C.

84-day report (March 14)

The 2017 Edisto Forage Bull Test (EFBT) began Dec. 20 in Blackville after the delivery of 54 bulls Dec. 6, 2016. Senior bulls eligible for the test were born Nov. 1, 2015-Jan. 31, 2016. Junior bulls eligible for the test were born Feb. 1-March 31, 2016.

The test is located at the Edisto Research & Education Center near Blackville, S.C., and offers a unique approach to gain-testing bulls. It is a 168-day pasture-based test. EFBT was developed, built and started in 1982 with the commercial cow-calf producer in mind. It capitalizes on the Southeast's advantage in its ability to grow high-quality, lush forages yearround. EFBT was designed to performance-test bulls in an environment in which bull buyers expect their progeny to perform.

Interim weights were scheduled to be taken May 9, with the bulls weighed off test June 6.
