Edisto Forage Bull Test Edisto Research & Education Center, Blacksville, S.C. On-test report (Nov. 16)

The 47 bulls delivered to the 2011 Edisto Forage Bull Test Monday, Nov. 15, were consigned by eight South Carolina (40 bulls) and two North Carolina (seven bulls) breeders. The bulls' on-test averages were 291 days of age, 728 lb., 45.6 in. tall and 2.50 lb. per day weight per day of age (WDA).

This is the first test with senior and junior bull age divisions, with the addition of December bulls. The bulls will start the test on forage soybean baleage (round bale silage) until ryegrass-crimson clover grazing is available. The bulls should go onto winter grazing between Thanksgiving and the first of December.

In order to get the requisite number of bulls to make the test and sale feasible, the Bull Test Committee modified the rules this year to make the weaning requirements and WDA requirements guidelines instead of requirements. They also moved the deadline back 10 days to give producers a little bit more latitude in their nominations.
