

IBEP Summer Test Feldun-Purdue Ag Center, Bedford, Ind. 91-day report (Aug. 22)

One hundred nineteen bulls and 12 getof-sire groups are being evaluated in the 2006 Indiana Beef Evaluation Program (IBEP) Summer Test. Bulls were delivered from owners in seven states, including Indiana, Illinois, Kentucky, Michigan, Montana, Ohio and Wisconsin. The index formula is calculated as 60% ADG ratio and 40% WDA ratio.

LSU Beef Bull Evaluation Test Dean Lee Research Station, Alexandria, La. 84-day report (Aug. 30)

The 96th Beef Bull Evaluation Test at Louisiana State University (LSU) began June 7 with 60 bulls representing three breeds and 10 breeders. Since the start of the test, one bull has been pulled for chronic bloating, and a second bull has been pulled due to injury. The cattle are being group-fed in nine pens. All bulls were treated with Cydectin[®] on June 7.
