## Tag Store Offers Expanded Options

It's now easier than ever for cattle producers to customize their herd identification. The American Angus Association Tag Store, available at [www.customcattletags.com](http://www.customcattletags.com), now allows farmers and ranchers to order numerous, customized ear tags and other ID options in less time.

"Previously, producers could customize tags with unique tag numbers, then add text that would be the same on each tag.
